Keyboard Stand

The following instructions are a rough guide to help you set up your Keyboard Stand correctly. Please check the contents below to see what should be included.

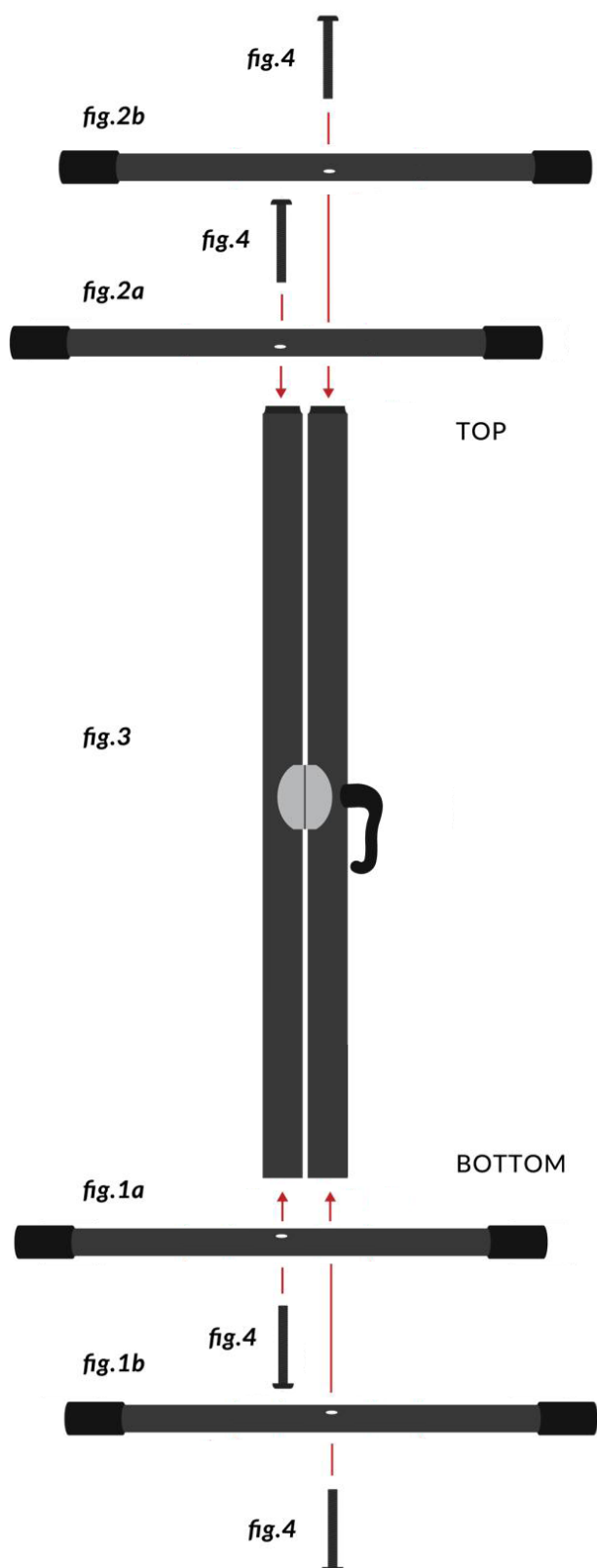

Notes

The bolts may come screwed into the ends of both X-Brace. Using the allen key provided ensure that all bolts are removed before assembly.



Before Assembly

Before assembly, take all of the contents and spread them out onto the floor following the illustration to the left.

Step 1

Firstly, take **fig.1a** and **fig.1b** and align the holes at the bottom of the X-Brace (**fig.3**). Then using two bolts (**fig.4**) attach **fig.1a** and **fig.1b** to the bottom of the X-Brace (**fig.3**).

Step 2

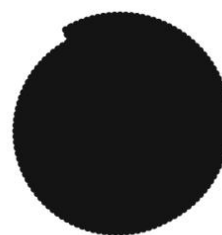
Next, take **fig.2a** and **fig.2b** and align the holes at the top of the X-Brace (**fig.3**). Then using the remaining two bolts (**fig.4**) attach **fig.2a** and **fig.2b** to the top of the X-Brace (**fig.3**).

Step 3

Now the stand is assembled, use the lever on the X-Brace (**fig.3**) to adjust to the desired height position.

Leveling

Some of the rubber feet at the base of the stand may have a slightly thicker section to them (see left). These are height adjusting rubber feet. If you find yourself having to rest your stand on uneven ground you can remove and switch your feet around, rotating the feet to adjust the balance of your stand.
